Post Oak Elementary School

- ⊕ School-wide, Primary Years Programme (PYP)
- ⊕ Language B: Chinese Immersion
- ⊕ 400 students, pre-K – 6th grade
- ⊕ Diversity at Post Oak Elementary School
 - 57% Non-white
 - 55% Free-Reduced Lunch



Eastern High School

- School-wide, Middle Years Programme, 7th – 10th grade (MYP)
- 1,140 students
- Language B: Chinese Immersion, French, Spanish
- Self-selected opportunity, Diploma Programme, 11th – 12th (DP)
 - 327 students in IB Diploma Program
 - 2014-15, 13 Full Diploma Seniors, 15 Full Diploma Juniors
- Diversity at Eastern High School
 - 68% Non-white
 - 78% Free-Reduced Lunch



University/College Credit

- Alma College – offers 32 credits for students who earn the Full IB Diploma
- Michigan State University – offers credit based on individual exam scores, typically a score of 5/7 issues college credit
- University of Michigan - offers credit based on individual exam scores, typically a score of 5/7 issues college credit in that subject area
- Most Michigan colleges & universities offer college credit for qualifying course scores from the IB Diploma Programme.

Eastern Graduate Advantages

- EHS Student Scholarship Amount for May 2014 ~ \$2 million
- 93% of the Class of 2014 attending post-secondary training
 - 73.4% two-year institution
 - 19.7% four-year institution
- Guided independent pre-college experience
 - Transition skills for college: organization, critical thinking, writing, study, and time management skills; approaches adults professionally, personal & social balance, utilizes resources, involved in activities
