On August 6, 2020 I presented the Return to Learning Plan to the Board of Education. At the same time, it was announced that no extracurricular activities would take place through the first marking period that ends on November 6, 2020.

Last week Governor Whitmer issued Executive Order 2020-176 which allowed for some sport activity. She also stated the following— "Sports organizers should follow the guidance of the Department of Health and Human Services regarding whether and how a sport can be played safely."
