Lansing School District Board of Education sets schedule to fill open board seat

(Lansing, MI) – The Lansing School District Board of Education has set a schedule to fill one vacated board seat that will officially open on May 8th with the impending departure of member Mrs. Keturah Bouyer.

Under Michigan law, a Board of Education has 30 days to fill vacancies. Applications of interest for a board seat are due in writing at 6 p.m., on May 15th, 2025. Media is welcome to promote the open application process and encouraged to share scheduling deadlines along with providing news coverage of the board member selection process.

Candidate interviews by the Board of Education are scheduled to begin at 6 p.m., on May 22. The Board of Education will deliberate and vote to select a new board member and the new member would be scheduled to take the oath of office at their first board meeting on June 6, 2025. The new board member will serve a partial term until the November 2026 election.
