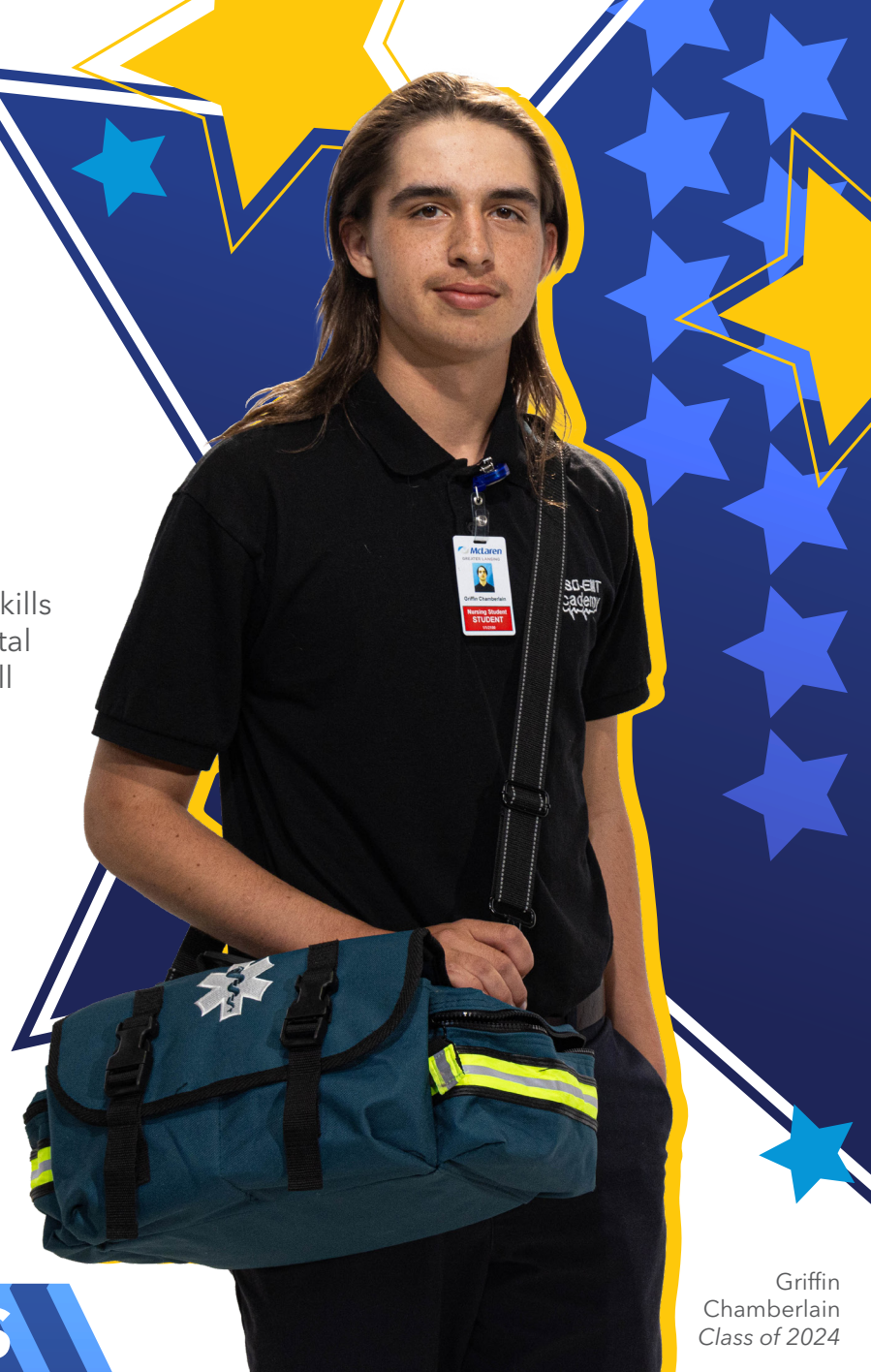
Career Technical Education (CTE)
