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District Kindergarten Screener – A screener given to all kindergarteners to assess current functioning and growth throughout the school year.

COR - An observation-based assessment instrument for children from birth through kindergarten. It is designed to measure children's progress in all early childhood programs (including, but not limited to those using the HighScope educational approach).

Brigance – This assessment measures progress in areas of perambulatory, gross motor skills, fine motor skills, pre-speech, speech and language, general knowledge, readiness, basic reading, manuscript writing, and basic math skills.

M-STEP (Michigan Student Testing Educational Program) – (State requirement) It consists of a set of tests designed to measure essential skills and strategies in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies. Students in grades 3, 4, 6 and 7 take English language arts and mathematics. Students in grades 5 take English language arts, mathematics, science and social studies. Students in grade 8 and 11 take science and social studies.

Michigan Merit Exam (MME) - SAT, ACT WorkKeys & M-STEP – The exam is administered in the Spring to all 11th graders and eligible 12th graders. It consists of three components: College Board SAT, WorkKeys job skills assessments in reading, mathematics, and "locating information", and Michigan-developed Science and Social Studies M-STEP. An overall MME performance score is calculated by combining their performance on three assessments (the ACT Plus Writing, WorkKeys, and Michigan Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies).

MI Access – An alternate assessment for students with an IEP specification. Students in grades 3 through 8 and grade 11 participate in the spring. There are three types of assessments: Functional Independence English language arts, mathematics and science; Participation and science; and Supported Independence and science.

NWEA MAP Growth – A computer adaptive interim growth assessment test administered 3 times a year to students in grades K – 12 designed to measure student achievement in the moment and growth over time. Students in K – 12 participate in mathematics and reading.

PSAT 8 – Summative assessment in the area of English language arts and math given to 8th graders replacing M-STEP ELA and Math.

PSAT 9 & PSAT 10 - Summative assessment in the area of English language arts and math given to 9th/10th graders.

WIDA (World Class Instructional Design Assessment) – A secure large-scale English language proficiency assessment administered to K through 12th grade students who have been identified as English Learners (ELs). It is given annually and is used to monitor students' progress in acquiring academic English. There is a **WIDA Alternate ACCESS** for ELs in grades 1–12 who are classified as English Learners (ELs) and have significant cognitive disabilities that prevent their meaningful participation in the ACCESS for ELs assessment.
