

Fire Science Academy

Students in the Fire Science Academy will learn the foundational skills needed to pursue a professional career in a fire department. The Lansing School District worked collaboratively with the Lansing Fire Department to design this academy as a way to prepare students for careers in the area of fire prevention, suppression, rescue, investigation, fire equipment service and emergency planning and preparedness.

Fire Science Academy students are expected to report, in uniform, at the beginning of each class period by standing at attention for roll call, presenting personal gear for inspection, and showing evidence of the completion of all assignments. The course is conducted on a military model where physical fitness, discipline, and decorum are highly valued.



Admission to the program is very competitive. Students will undergo a thorough review of academic and personal preparation where grades, attendance, citizenship, and teacher references will be considered. Each applicant will be interviewed by a panel of current firefighters and LSD staff to determine the true level of interest and dedication to the profession.

Instruction will be held in person at the Hill Center in the afternoons.
