Program Assistance

- Assist naturalist with school programs and camps

- Assist with events

Land Management

- Assist in planning, conducting and monitoring invasive species removal
- Participate in land management activities, including habitat restoration
- Participate in on-site species inventory (plants, animals, birds)
- Participate in scheduled workday activities
- Perform routine trail inspection & maintenance
- Maintain gardens around buildings

Other Duties

- Fill and cleaning bird feeders
- Maintain program spaces around campus
- Monitor/Maintain Nesting boxes
- Photograph programs, habitats, and wildlife
- Assist in cleaning of Center including duties like mopping, dusting, wiping windows, etc.
