Dear Lansing School District Family:

We are committed to providing a safe working environment for all employees. Accident and injury prevention is our main goal, but if you are injured while on the job, we want to make sure you receive the care needed to get well again.

The Lansing School District is partnered with Sparrow Occupational Health Services to ensure quality medical treatment and a smooth process for workers' compensation claims. Medical treatment outside of Sparrow OHS may **NOT** be eligible for compensation under the state's workers' compensation law.

All employees should be familiar with the steps necessary to seek treatment for injuries occurring at work. Our procedure is listed below.

When an employee is injured

- Employee reports accident to immediate supervisor.
- If it is not an emergency, employee <u>immediately</u> completes a Worker's Comp Incident Report form and if available, sees an onsite nurse.
- If the employee chooses to seek treatment, the supervisor <u>immediately</u> emails the Worker's Comp Incident Report form to Human Resources at <u>hrdept@lansingschools.net</u> and notifies the HR department by phone.
- A member of Human Resources will assure that the employee has the proper authorization for treatment at Sparrow OHS.
- After the clinic visit, employees should provide a hard copy of the clinic's activity status report to their supervisor.
- Sparrow OHS will work with our workers' compensation claim representative to ensure quality of care and approve future visits and prescribed treatments, including physical therapy, diagnostic tests and specialist referrals.
- Human Resources will work with employee's supervisor on restricted work options.

Any time an employee is injured an injury report should be completed. On the report the employee must indicate if they are choosing to seek treatment at Sparrow OHS for their injuries or not seek medical treatment.
