Mrs. Cadogan's Class:

Inquiry into Literacy: Students worked on writing the cause and effect relationships in the story "The Race". Students will read about reptiles and amphibians. We will discuss how their characteristics contributes to their responsibilities in their environment.

Inquiry into Foundational Skills: Students built up some fluency with CVCe words, also known as "magic e" words. We will begin working on R-Controlled vowels, also known as "Bossy R" words.

Inquiry into Sight Words: Students played with and practiced their sight words: were, her, friends, they, said. In the future, we will work on: why, all, what, there, who.

Inquiry into Science: Students will apply their understanding of structure and function and animal and plant defenses as they design solutions to protect the aquarium food supply from wild animals (we are finally using the recycled materials):).
