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Central idea: Conflicts in relationships are the result of opinions and reactions

Related concepts: Reactions/Conflict/Opinions **Lines of inquiry:** (Highlighted is this week's emphasis)

- Ways relationships influence reactions (Causation)
- Different opinions towards common ideas (Perspective)
- Ways conflict changes relationships (Changes)

Inquiry into Reading: Students will read informational text about cougars and their relationship with the environment as they explore the essential question "What can a scientist learn by observing the behaviors of a particular animal?" Inquiry into Writing: Students will participate in debates as they continue to inquire about different opinions.

Inquiry into Chinese Language Arts: After reading, "Family Trip" students will learn the relationship between making hypothesis and the outcome.

Inquiry into Math: Students will discuss the relationship between whole numbers and decimals by using the Place-Value Chart.

Inquiry into Science: We will be wrapping up Modeling Matter and then beginning our unit on Earth Systems and our relationships with the Earth's resources.

Inquiry into Social Studies: We will be studying the relationship between the European countries and the colonies they had in North America.
