September 2008 IBO assigns Lisa Rhoads from

Fort Collins, Colorado as our consultant. Staff continues to work on units making sure our curriculum is both horizontally and vertically aligned. At least 3 planners per grade level must be

developed, taught, reflected upon, and

revised (this school year).

November 2008

Official IBO Consultation Visit by Lisa Rhoads. (As a mentor, Lisa Will spend 2 days at the school to evaluate progress towards meeting authorization requirements, and provides commendations/recommendations. The PYP Coordinator then provides two follow-up "progress" reports to the consultant.

December 2008
-June2009

Staff works to address recommendations outlined in consultant's report and continues working towards Authorization requirements. Staff continues to receive additional training.

June 2009

Submit Application Part B for Authorization.

June 2009-August 2009 Continue to develop units-all 6 planners need to be developed taught, reflected on, and revised by Authorization visit.

2009/2010 School Year Staff implements all 6 planners according to Post Oak's Programme of Inquiry. IBO Official Authorization team will visit Post Oak (hopefully during late winter/early spring) to determine if all requirements have been met. (2-3 day visit, parents/staff/students are also

interviewed)

June 2010

Post Oak's PYP Authorization is Determined by the IBO.
