WHAT IS INSIGHTS?

INSIGHTS provides students of similar academic ability an opportunity to learn and study together. The primary purpose of INSIGHTS is to give academically talented students opportunities to enhance their learning and increase their critical thinking and problem-solving skills. An annual theme shapes the yearlong studies and introduces the students to scientific inquiry in active learning situations.

The INSIGHTS program offers three courses: Technology; Science and Mathematics (SM); and Social Studies and Language Arts (SL).

How are INSIGHTS Students Selected?

- Student must attend school in the Lansing School District
- Must have academic potential as determined by the following considerations:
 - Academic Performance
- · A Teacher Recommendation
- · Reasoning Test
- · A Parent Recommendation
- An INSIGHTS application from both Teacher and Parent must be completed for each applicant. INSIGHTS applications are available through the Elementary Talent Development Center.

How are INSIGHTS Students Evaluated?

The Elementary Talent Development teachers will assess each student's participation in the INSIGHTS program. Students also reflect on and evaluate their own achievement and interpersonal development. A final report will be provided to each student, parent and home school. INSIGHTS teachers are available for individual consultation during the school year.
